II. ELA

- A. Bob McFarland new director of IT Strategy and Policy at GTA. He proposes that GIS be viewed as part of a Community of Interest. In this way, GIS activities could receive funding via line item budget
 - i. No funding for Clearinghouse from GTA in the future
- B. ELA being rewritten; will probably more resemble the State's Microsoft agreement
- C. State Strategic Plan, the GIS Scorecard should be used to flow into this.
