Federal FY11 funding to map CSRA counties: Columbia, Lincoln, Richmond, Burke (within Savannah Basin)

-Ideas for completing statewide LidAR

Coordinate with GEMA to possibly use DHS funds

Special service districts to collect revenue based on benefit (certain areas/communities would benefit more than others)

Create/maintain a database of which have LiDAR and which may do so in the future

Create inter-jurisdictional MOUs

Coastal RC is a good example, Mountain RC and ARC too ARC tentatively has 7 counties 2013

-NOAA Contracts

Currently RFQ based

NOAA and partners choose contractors

MOU between NOAA and partners to agree to do work

MOU can be updated to raise the "ceiling" of funding

DNR MOU ceiling has recently been raised

Annex: scope of work

Work starts when NOAA receives funds

Leftover money returned

Contractors are vetted thru RFQ process

NOAA doesn't charge for contract

Will review data and coordinate contract

Possible hurdles

Time to get MOU in place

Data purchased thru contract becomes public domain

Some LiDAR costs

\$200-300/sq mile for LiDAR with breaklines and which meets FEMA specs (QL3)

QA/QC approx. 10% - 15% of total cost or approx. \$45/sq mile

This mainly involved their use of the HAZUS tool and how they have
used data such as LiDAR to enhance tools for risk assessment
They would like to see more involvement in HAZUS fro Georgia
